



Patient's guide to diagnostic testing

Dear Patient:

Your doctor has determined that in order to better diagnose your specific case, further tests will need to be conducted. The test results will assist the doctor in establishing a treatment plan customized to your needs. The diagnostic tests will not create any side effects, so you may resume your normal activities the same day. A board certified neurologist will review your test results and send a complete report to your doctor within a week. Your test has been scheduled for:

Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your appointment to ensure adequate time for your diagnostic tests. Patient checklist:

Meals There are no restrictions to your normal diet. Avoid tobacco and caffeine two hours before your test.

Clothing The technician will need to administer the test on your arms, legs and/or back. Please wear loose fitting clothing. Please do not wear jeans.

Lotions For best results bathe or shower before your test. Body oils may interfere with the test results. Please do not use lotions, bath oils or creams before your test.

Medications Do not take anti-inflammatory medication 4-6 hours prior to your test.

Be on time Make sure you allow the proper time for your test. A test usually takes up to 30 minutes per study performed.
